WHEREAS: Skin self-examinations should be performed on a monthly basis because skin cancers are highly treatable

when detected early and

WHEREAS: Save Your Skin Foundation is dedicated to the fight against non-melanoma skin cancers, melanoma and

ocular melanoma through nationwide education, advocacy, and awareness initiatives.
